

The arrest of asylum seekers by Finnish police is condemned

To the Finnish freedom-loving representatives of parliament and people

In few recent days, the Finnish police have arrested more than 20 asylum seekers from Iran and other countries. These asylum seekers have been waiting to get permission for settlement and asylum from the Finnish government for years. The Finnish central court has given the order of their expelling and detention. Currently these asylum seekers are in detention and they can be deported at any time.

These asylum seekers have escaped the hell created by dictator governments like the Islamic Republic of Iran who execute their political dissidents as the whole world saw the recent examples of it in Kurdistan of Iran.

This action by the Finnish government is a clear entrenchment and ignoring of human rights and United Nations Immigration Convention. Thereby we condemn this action by the Finnish police and government and ask for their immediate release and granting them the permission for settlement and asylum.

We ask all the freedom-loving people, representatives of parliament, UN's high commissioner, Amnesty International and humanitarian organizations to act immediately regarding this and urge the Finnish government to annul the given order against these asylum seekers.
