

**No to imperialist Reactionaries ! No to the Reactionary Regime
of the Islamic Republic!**

**A call for participation in international protests in front of the G8
summit.**

From the 6th to the 8th of June 2007, the leaders of the 8 industrial states, known as the G8, will gather in Heiligendamm, Germany, to discuss further criminal activities in the Middle East and to haggle over the share of each country from the exploitation and pillage of the peoples of the world. There is a possibility that US military plans for an aggression against Iran will be central to these discussions.

As always, anti globalisation activists from throughout Europe and other countries will gather in front of this gathering to raise their voices in protest on behalf of billions of the inhabitants of our planet. Following the 11th of Sept 2001 and since the start of the war and occupation of Iraq and Afghanistan, this vast anti globalisation movement has also become the voice of those opposed to imperialist wars. International protests in front of the G8 summit will also reflect solidarity of the peoples of the world against the capitalist system.

Our participation in these widespread protests will provide a great opportunity to forge unity and solidarity between the communist movement and the revolutionary workers movement in Iran with communist and radical revolutionary groups and individuals in Europe, in the West and throughout the world.

We, left, communist forces, radical elements of the workers movement and other democratic, equality seeking forces in Iran, will participate in the protests in front of the G8 Summit and will join the worldwide protests against war and the militarist domination of US imperialism and its allies, we will strengthen the radical anti capitalist forces in these protests and will call for the transformation of the current movement to a united large movement against capitalist exploitation. With our active presence, we will not allow fundamentalist and nationalist, expansionist Iranian forces to put themselves forward. It is vital that this powerful international protest separates its ranks from the reactionary forces of Islam and nationalism and pursues its struggle against war mongers all forms of imperialist domination, capitalists and the regime of the Islamic Republic in Iran, independently.

The ruinous consequences of neo liberal policies of US imperialism and other Western countries is exposed throughout the world. The destructive wars of Iraq and Afghanistan have clearly shown the fierceness of the capitalist order the true nature of its 'democracy'. US's militarist imperialism supported by powerful capitalist countries, has led to the death of over 650,000 innocent Iraqis and homelessness, devastation and the collapse of all forms of social lives for over 4million citizens of that country. Billions of dollars extracted from the labour of the working people in these countries has been spent on the US military machine in Iraq and the region. US strategy in the region, in practical coordination with the Islamic Republic regime and other reactionary forces has enhanced

Islamic fanaticism in the region, helping sectarian and tribal wars between Sunnis and Shias.

The defeat and political military impasse facing the United States has led Pentagon's military machine to such a quagmire that it is unlikely even the neo conservatives residing in the White House could consider a full scale war (as in Iraq) against Iran. However the US military is making widespread preparations in the Middle East, especially by setting up many military bases near Iran, raising the spectre of war itself, making the Middle East an explosive focus for full scale wars. It is in such circumstances that large sections of the Iranian people are weary of US military adventurism as well as the warmongering of the Islamic regime itself.

The Islamic Republic Regime of Iran has kept its dictatorial, repressive rule with the help and support of imperialist governments and capitalist institutions, has in the meantime executed thousands of communists and revolutionaries, stifled the democratic and just struggles of its own citizens, creating a living hell for the majority of the population. Now it aims to use its nuclear program and its economic, geographic situation in the Middle East to become a major power in the Middle East. The survival strategy of the Islamic Republic regime in Iran is to use US military threats as a blessing to reinforce the repression of the workers movement and the struggles of the Iranian people, while mobilising its Islamic reactionary forces while gaining the support of expansionist Iranian forces.

It is clear that neither the aims of the US for becoming the unchallenged superpower in the region nor Iran's ambitions to gain a special position in the imperialist reactionary order in the Middle East have anything to do with the interests of the oppressed people of Iran and other countries in the Middle East and the world. We must constantly expose the true nature and content of imperialist policies pursued by the United States and other Western governments in their confrontations with Iran, regarding the nuclear issue. In order to free ourselves of the nightmare of the Islamic regime, we must concentrate our efforts in strengthening the workers movement as well as other independent social movements, in order to prepare for a revolution whose first task will be the overthrow of the Islamic Republic regime.

We are joining the international mass movement against capitalism, against war and against US and Western hegemony, against any intervention in Iran and the region and against the regime of the Islamic Republic, reactionary religious and nationalist forces, in the hope that the world will hear our protest.

Workers and freedom seeking peoples of Iran will succeed in bringing about fundamental change in the regrettable situation in Iran, relying on their own direct, organised and conscious struggles against any form of imperialist intervention. We are relying on the powerful workers movement, the women's movement, the revolutionary movement in Kurdistan, the struggles of students and teachers as well as the international solidarity shown by the international anti war, anti capitalist movement to

overthrow the dictatorial regime of the Islamic Republic and building a free , equal society .

Let us rise for a world free of oppression and exploitation!
Long live the worldwide movement against imperialist war and the capitalist system!
