Workers of NAIL IRAN COMPANY gathered in front of department of inspection of CHAHARMAHAL and BAKHTIARI province. The protester workers wanted employers and the regime responsible(s) to investigate to their difficulties. These workers said that they would continue their gatherings in the future, if nobody took care of their problems.

A worker named HAMDOLLAH committed suicide because he had been unemployed by his employer. When this young person understood that authority did not pay attention to his complaint he set fire to himself.

TEHRAN
6/23/2006

Employers of TEHRAN'S SHAHAB COMPANY discharged fifty workers in the course of past days. The discharged workers have reported employers to authority, because they want to know that for what reason they have been fired out.

6/24/2006

6/24/2006

BOSHEHR
6/25/2006

When activity of IRAN SADRA COMPANY came to an end, employers of this company discharged 400 workers. The discharged labours have gathered in front of the regime organizations several times. These workers have asked for going back to work.

BANDAR ANZALI
6/25/06

Two hundred and fifty discharged workers protested in front of governor's office of the above-named city. These workers worked for municipality of BANDAR ANZALI. It is necessary to say that they had not gotten their delayed wages and other benefits too.

BANDAR ABBAS

6/27/06

More than 60 workers who work for NOGHAN SANAT COMPANY have struck since last week. These workers have not received any wages for last 3 months. At present, employers have made an appointment to pay workers' salaries until ten more days.

GHAZVIN

6/27/06

All of factory workers who worked for ELBURZ'S CHINI FACTORY were unemployed by their employer. The above-named factory met crisis when it transferred to private portion. It is necessary to say that about 22 factories have been closed and thousands labours have been unemployed in GHAZVIN PROVINCE.

6/27/06

Employers of NAKHRAN COMPANY have discharged 20 workers. Those employers had discharged 40 workers in last month too. At present, the discharged workers have reported their employers to the regime organizations.
