

## **LORESTAN**

07/01/07

Tens factory workers who were employees of LORESTAN Refrigerator Factory, protested in front of governor's office of the above-named province on the first of July. On the basis of reports, after closing this factory about 250 workers were unemployed without any wages and other benefits. Discharged workers asked for going back to work and paying their salaries.

## **TEHRAN**

07/03/07

Workers of a contract company related to Tehran Electricity Company, gathered in front of office of their workplace on the 3rd of July. These workers asked for investigating to their difficulties.

07/13/07

Mr. MANSOUR OSANLOO, president of the workers' syndicate of Tehran and Suburb Bus Company transferred to AVIN Prison. As everyone knows, he had been abducted by the police on July 10, 2007.

07/15/07

Workers of Iran KHODRO Company asked for releasing MAHMOUD SALEHI and MANSOUR OSANLOO, the well-known worker's activists on July 15, 2007.

## **VARAMIN**

07/03/07

Municipality's employees of the above-mentioned city, protested in front of their workplace, because they have not gotten any salary for a few months! Workers said that they would go on strike, if employers didn't take care of their problems.

## **GHAZVIN**

07/03/07

In the course of this month, tens workers of PARS Company, have protested in front of governor's office of GHAZVIN several times because they haven't still gotten their delayed wages.

Let it not remain that those workers had gathered in front of AHMADINEJAD'S office too.

## **BOSHEHR**

07/04/07

More than 40 discharged workers whom were employees of a leather factory in the city of SHABESTAR, protested in front of governor's office of BOSHEHR Province on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Most of these workers have 15 years service. According to received reports, these workers have been fired without any reason.

## **TABRIZ**

07/06/07

Workers of TABRIZ'S Municipality, protested because of unpaid salaries on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> of July 2007. It is said that the regime forces

besieged protesters in a few minutes and they also didn't let workers to continue their protest.

07/28/07

A workers' activist named CHANGIZ BAKHTAVAR has been sentenced to 15 months imprisonment. Must say, BAKHTAVAR also had been arrested by the Islamic regime four months ago.

### **Events at workplace**

07/08/07

-An immigrant worker named Mohammed fell into a pit and lost his life when he was working.

-A worker named MAJID was suffocated when he was digging a well.

-Someone else was killed as the result of wall falling in the city of SAJAD SHAHR.

### **ARDEBIL**

07/09/07

In the course of past months, workers of ARTA Machine, have gathered in front of governor's office of this city and have asked for taking care of their claims many times. These workers have not gotten any wages for five months! During that protest, the regime forces wanted to disperse workers, but workers continued to their protest bravely.

### **SANANDAJ**

07/10/07

11 workers' activists whom had been arrested on May 1<sup>st</sup> 2007, were trialed by the regime revolution court on July 10, 2007. KHALED SAVARI, EGHBAL LATIFI, YADOLLAH MORADI, TAYOB MOLAI, FARS GAVELIAN, SEDIGH AMJADI, ABBAS ANDARYARI, HABIB KLKANI, MOHYEH RAJABI, TAYOB CHATANI and SEDIGH SOBHANI are trialed workers. The regime also wants to trial two others in the name of SHIS AMANI and SEDIGH KARIMI.

07/10/07

On the basis of received news, SHAHO'S employees went on strike on July 10<sup>th</sup>. Should say that employers have not paid workers' salaries for two months! It's said that employers had promised to pay workers' claims before.

07/12/07

Mr. MAHMOUD SALEHI, the well-known activist of Iranian workers' movement, had been transferred to the hospital by reason of seriousness his bodily situation on 11<sup>th</sup> of July. It is necessary to say that in spite of doctors' recommendation based on release him, the regime forces took him back to jail after two hours.

07/24/07

Employers of PARRIS Company have not paid any wages to their employees for two months and they don't want to investigate workers' problems. Also after punishing labor's protests of the above-named company in 2006, the employers had faired a few workers.

### **ESFEHAN**

07/11/07

Workers of D. M. T. Factory went on strike and asked for investigating to their problems. These workers also requested responsible(s) to change managing director of the factory.

07/21/07

A teacher named HAMID MAJIRI, who had been arrested in the course of the Iranian teachers' protests, was fired by the government employees' court on the 21st July.

On Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of July about 120 factory workers whom work for PARS HASAS and T.I.G.D Companies went on strike. Eyewitnesses said that employers were compelled to paying delayed salaries to their employees on the same day.
